The Art Sale Committee invites professional artists who are LC Alumni and current LC student artists to submit to the Tiger Fund Art Sale that takes place May 11 and 12, 2024, at Lewis and Clark High School.

ELIGIBILITY & CONDITIONS:

- All entries must be the artist's original work.
- Artists may submit up to three (3) entries. The jurors decide the number of works selected for exhibition. Artists are asked to submit an artist's statement with their submissions. (Please attach to entry form).
- Jurors reserve the right to not accept works due to toxic materials, excessive size, weight, inappropriate content or difficulty in presentation.
- Artwork must be ready for hanging or installation. Framed and unframed pieces must have wire for hanging (no saw hooks).
- Titles and prices will be listed as they appear on entry forms. No changes will be made after entry forms are received.
- All accepted artwork must remain in the gallery for the duration of the exhibition.

SALES:

There are two options for artists;

- 1) 100% donation to the Lewis and Clark Tiger Fund
- 2) Commission split to be determined between the artist and the Lewis and Clark Tiger Fund Steering Committee

Please list the price (as it should appear on the gallery label) for each submitted piece on the entry form AND which option you would like to use. Payment to artists will be mailed 4-6 weeks after the close of the sale. In order to expedite the processing of artists' commission, we request that you provide us with a completed W-9 form at the time of entry.

Selection Notification, (via email): Friday, April 12

Deadline for delivery to Lewis and Clark High School in Spokane, between May 6 -May 9, 2024, 10am-4pm, or received by mail by May 8, 2024. If your art work is selected, instructions will be included with the selection notification.

Sale Dates: May 11 - May 12, 2024

Pick-up of non-sold work: May 12 after 5pm or May 13, 10am-4pm, Lewis and Clark High School Office. Out of town pieces will be mailed back on the 14th providing there is a pre-paid return shipment form included in the packaging.
